

PUBLIC NOTICE: LANE CLOSURES IN LANSDOWNE

The City of Cape Town's Urban Mobility Directorate advises the public of temporary lane closures along Racecourse Road. The closures are planned in two phases in order to keep traffic flowing in both directions at all times, but motorists are advised to expect delays and to plan accordingly.

Racecourse Road will be affected from Prince Arthur Road to the Lansdowne Road overpass, as follows:

24 April - 15 May 2025

- The two lanes serving traffic towards the M5/Kromboom Parkway will be closed. The remaining two lanes will be used to accommodate traffic in both directions.
- The intersection of Leafmore Road and Racecourse Road will be closed. Traffic will be detoured via Prince Arthur Road and Kritzinger Road.

16 May - 30 May 2025

- The two lanes serving traffic towards Jan Smuts Drive will be closed. The remaining two lanes will be used to accommodate traffic in both directions.
- The intersection of Leafmore Road and Racecourse Road will be closed. Traffic will be detoured via Prince Arthur Road and Kritzinger Road.

The work will regrettably add to congestion and motorists are advised to:

- Plan for longer journey times
- Make use of lift clubs, ride-sharing or public transport
- Avoid peak traffic times
