CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

TEMPORARY LANE SHIFT AZ BERMAN DRIVE, MITCHELLS PLAIN

The City of Cape Town is continuing with transport infrastructure upgrades along AZ Berman Drive. To keep work on track and ensure safety, temporary traffic changes will be in place. These include temporary lane shifts to allow construction to continue safely.

These changes are planned from 25th August 2025 to mid-2026 but may be affected by weather or other unforeseen delays.

Temporary Traffic Lane Shift

- A traffic shift will take place along AZ Berman Drive, between Katjiepiering Street and Kerrem Street (BP Garage).
- Traffic will move from the current southbound lane (towards Khayelitsha) to the newly completed northbound lane (towards Cape Town).
- Vehicles will travel in both directions using one lane in each direction.
- Cones and road markings will separate the lanes and guide drivers through the work zone.
- Pedestrian access will remain open and safely separated from construction by a 1.2m fence on the eastern (sidewalk) edge.
- No parking will be allowed on the new northbound lane and or within the construction area.

Updated Intersection Access

- Petunia Street and Morgenster Road will reopen at their intersections with AZ Berman Drive.
- Kerrem Street will remain partially closed. The three outbound lanes from Promenade Mall will be closed to traffic. The two inbound lanes will be used to accommodate vehicles traveling in both directions.
- Charlie Street will remain partially closed. There will be 2 lanes available, 1 in and 1 out.
- Westpoort Drive (West) scheduled for closure as soon as Morgenster is opened.
- Highlands (East) scheduled for closure as soon as Morgenster is opened.

All homes, businesses, and public facilities with City of Cape Town-approved access will remain accessible throughout the construction period.

Motorists should plan ahead and allow for extra travel time.
