## PROPOSED UPGRADE OF THE CLAREMONT BUS FACILITY

The City of Cape Town plans to upgrade the bus facility opposite the Claremont rail station in order to construct a station for future MyCiTi services.

The Cape Town City Council approved the rollout of the next phase of MyCiTi bus services following an extensive public participation process in 2015. Phase 2A will connect Khayelitsha and Mitchells Plain with the hubs of Claremont and Wynberg through direct, reliable, affordable and safe public transport.

These services require the redesign of the existing bus facility in Claremont in order to accommodate the construction of a MyCiTi station, which will serve as the hub for future bus services from Claremont.

The proposed station will form part of the Claremont public transport interchange (PTI), ensuring quick, easy and safe access to other public transport services including rail, minibus taxis, other bus services.

The planned upgrade will also benefit the broader precinct, through the planting of trees and landscaping, as well as through measures to ensure safer walking and a more pleasant travel experience for all.
