Upgrades along AZ Berman Drive in full swing

Construction is in full swing in Mitchells Plain. Various intersections are planned for temporary closures and traffic will soon be shifted to allow construction to continue safely in the area.

Road and Lane Closures

- Petunia Street will be closed at the intersection with AZ Berman Drive. Detour via Marguerite Road.
- Morgenster Road is closed at the intersection with AZ Berman Drive. Detour via Merrydale Avenue to Highlands Drive or via Merrydale to Wespoort Road.
- On Kerrem Street, the three outbound lanes from Promenade Mall will be closed to traffic. The two inbound lanes will be used to accommodate vehicles traveling in both directions.

Upcoming Traffic Changes

The intersections at Bottlebrush and Highlands Roads have re-opened to traffic. The intersection at Marguerite Road will also soon be re-opened.

Traffic will shift as follows between Petunia Street and Katjiefiering Street:

- Traffic will shift from the current southbound lane (towards Khayelitsha) to the newly reconstructed northbound lane (towards Cape Town).
- Traffic will operate with one lane in each direction. Cones and road markings will guide and ensure the safety of all road users.

Roadworks underway in the Claremont area

Work has commenced with the major upgrade of Imam Haron, Chichester and Stanhope Roads in Claremont.

Road and lane closures are in effect to accommodate the work, which will result in road upgrades, dedicated bus lanes, stops and stations, upgrading of intersections with traffic signals, and safer walking and cycling facilities for all.

The demolition of 8 properties acquired to accommodate the road widening is also set

to start in June. Work may result in excessive noise but will be restricted

to weekdays between 09:00 and 17:30 to limit disruptions to residents.



Final stretch for Spine Road depots

The construction of two bus depots on Spine Road is nearly complete, with minor works and the finishing touches including paving and landscaping underway at both facilities.

These side-by-side facilities at the intersection with Mew Way will be used by vehicle operating companies and will serve as the base for Phase 2A bus operations.

Traffic changes on Govan Mbeki Road

Work has started along Govan Mbeki Road, extending from Swartklip Road to Luzuko Drive, and from Luzuko Drive to Indwe Road.

The westbound carriageway of Govan Mbeki Road (towards Cape Town) will be closed between Swartklip Road (M49) and Hammer Road for approximately three months. This timeline may shift due to weather conditions or unforeseen delays.

Meanwhile, construction is gaining momentum in Ikwezi Park, where the contractor is nearly complete

with a new site camp. Work will soon commence with assessing and relocating

any underground services between the R300 bridge and Morning Star Drive.



Enhanced security in Nyanga

Temporary security fencing is being installed to improve safety and manage access to the construction site in order to keep workers and the public safe throughout the project. In addition, two additional security companies are being appointed from the affected local wards.

These appointments will further strengthen on-site security and help ensure that construction activities can continue without disruption.

Sky Circle work reaches new heights

Construction is underway with scaffolding in the centre island of the temporary traffic circle at the intersection of Govan Mbeki Road and Jan Smuts Drive.

The intersection was converted into a temporary traffic circle to accommodate the building of the bridge overhead. It will remain in place until construction of the Sky Circle is complete, currently planned for the end of 2026.

The public are also reminded of the ongoing partial, temporary closure of Shadwin

Road at the intersection with Govan Mbeki Road until July 2025 to accommodate work. Motorists can use the

detour in place to access the Lansdowne Corner Shopping Centre via Downberg Road and Hanover Park Avenue.



Duinefontein Road update

Construction is progressing at the Duinefontein Road intersection, where a new mini-traffic circle is being installed.

This roundabout is designed to improve traffic flow and safety.

In addition, work is underway on the westbound carriageway. Crews are currently milling the road surface in preparation for the construction of a new dual carriageway.

Excavation is also in progress to install large water chambers beneath the westbound lanes, which form part of the improved stormwater management system.
