CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC LANE SHIFT AZ BERMAN DRIVE, MITCHELLS PLAIN

The City of Cape Town is continuing with transport infrastructure upgrades along AZ Berman Drive. To keep construction progressing safely, a traffic lane switch will start at the end of October 2025, pending any weather-related or other unforeseen delays.

Current traffic layout

- Traffic currently travels on the northbound lane (towards Cape Town) between Stock Road and Kerrem Street.
- From Kerrem Street to Wespoort Drive, traffic is currently using the southbound lane (towards Khayelitsha).

New temporary traffic layout

- All vehicles will travel on the northbound lane in both directions, from Stock Road to Wespoort Drive.
- Two lanes in each direction will remain open and clearly marked.
- Road cones and signage will guide motorists safely through the area.
- Pedestrian access will remain open and separated from construction by safety fencing

Temporary bus stops

- New temporary bus stops will be in place along AZ Berman Drive during this period.
- These stops will serve existing public transport routes and will be clearly marked on the accompanying map.
- Please use the designated stops and follow on-site signage for safety.

All homes, businesses, and public facilities will remain accessible throughout the construction period. Traffic signage will guide road users through the area. Motorists should plan ahead and allow for extra travel time.
