

# CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

## TEMPORARY LANE SHIFTS

### GOVAN MBEKI ROAD, GUGULETHU

The City of Cape Town is extending the current temporary traffic layout along Govan Mbeki Road as construction progresses on the transport infrastructure upgrades in the area.

#### The traffic layout

- The current construction zone between Heinz Road and NY72 Road will shift further along Govan Mbeki Road as work continues.
- Changes will be implemented in phases from early March 2026.
- The lane adjustments at Jakes Gerwel Bridge and near the Vygekraal intersection will remain in place for approximately four months.
- The broader temporary traffic layout is expected to remain for approximately eight to twelve months as construction progresses.

#### What to expect

- Traffic travelling towards Nyanga (eastbound) will be reduced to a single lane at the Jakes Gerwel Bridge
- Traffic travelling towards Lansdowne (westbound) will move through a temporary lane shift past the Vygekraal intersection.
- Traffic will continue to flow in both directions along Govan Mbeki Road

#### Access and safety

- Access to all homes, businesses and public facilities will remain open
- Traffic officials and signage will guide road users safely through the area
- Motorists should allow for additional travel time during peak periods
