

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

PERMANENT MYCITI STOPS

VICTORIA ROAD, HOUT BAY

As part of the City of Cape Town's ongoing initiative to improve public transport services, the phased construction of MyCiTi bus stops in Victoria Road, Hout Bay will take place between August and November 2026.

Following a successful public participation process, this involves replacing temporary bus stops with permanent infrastructure.

As a result, some permanent bus stops will be built a few metres from their original locations to comply with road safety requirements, maintain design consistency and address space limitations.

Stops affected

- Imizamo Yethu eastbound
- Imizamo Yethu westbound

What to expect

- MyCiTi bus services will remain fully operational during construction, although minor delays may occur.
- Temporary lane closures may occur while construction work is in progress.
- The Imizamo Yethu eastbound and westbound bus stop poles will be temporarily relocated to Hout Bay Main Road, within close proximity of the Imizamo Yethu Community
- Access to properties will be maintained at all times.
- Traffic signage and safety officials will guide residents and motorists through the affected area.
- Passengers are encouraged to plan ahead and to download the MyCiTi app for the latest bus times.
