

CONSTRUCTION NOTICE

PERMANENT MYCITI STOPS

ALBERT ROAD, WOODSTOCK

As part of the City of Cape Town's ongoing initiative to improve public transport services, the phased construction of MyCiTi bus stops in Albert Road, Woodstock will take place between July and November 2026.

These works involve replacing temporary bus stops with permanent structures across the footprint, following a successful public participation process.

As a result, some permanent bus stops will be built a few meters from their original locations to comply with road safety requirements, maintain design consistency and address space limitations.

Stops affected

- Barron eastbound
- Biscuit Mill eastbound
- Barron westbound
- Biscuit Mill westbound

What to expect

- Services will remain fully operational during construction, although minor delays may occur.
- Temporary lane closures may occur while construction work is in progress.
- Parking bays near these stops may be temporarily unavailable.
- Temporary MyCiTi bus stop poles will be relocated approximately 30 metres from the active work area to safeguard all road users.
- Access to properties will be maintained at all times.
- Traffic signage and safety officials will guide residents and motorists through the affected area.
- Passengers are encouraged to plan ahead and to download the MyCiTi app for the latest bus times.

Motorists, pedestrians and cyclists are advised to plan ahead and allow extra travel time.
